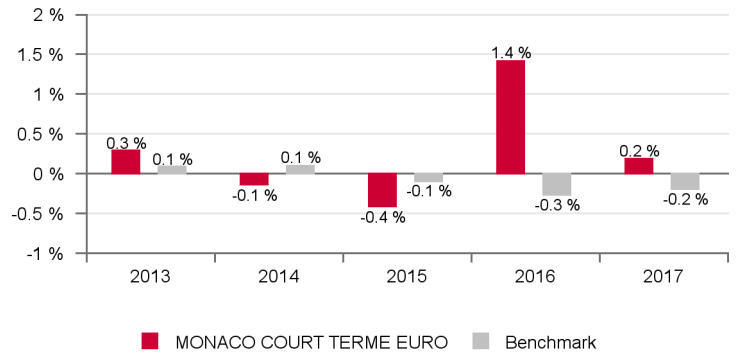

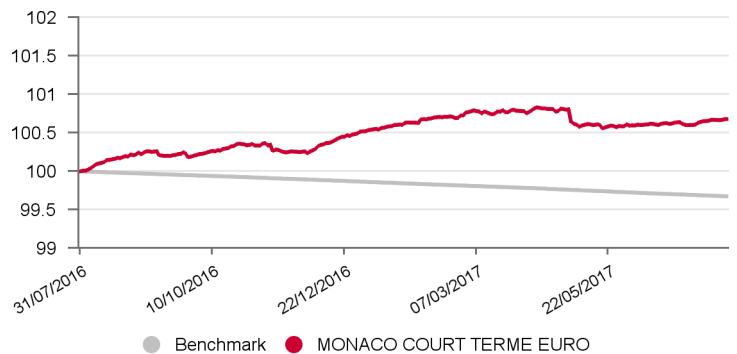

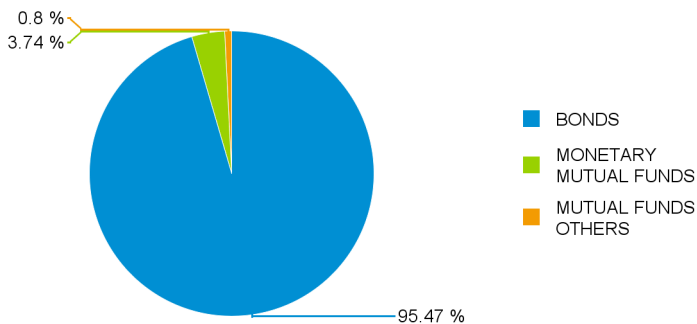
Trailing 1 year performance (basis 100)
